

Parks Team Meeting Minutes  
November 9, 2016  
3:30 p.m.

The meeting came to order on November 9<sup>th</sup> at 3:30 p.m.

Present were, City Councilmen Neal James, Jim Bockelman, and Rob Jackson, Sacajawea Center Director Lin Gray, Connor Swersey, Mary Wright, and Earl Grief.

1. Connor Swersey came in to talk about his senior project. He wants to build a Bicycle pump track and is looking for a location for the track. He wants to get the biking community involved and start fund raising in order to get the track professionally designed and built. We discussed possible locations throughout the valley and avenues to get grants. Connor is to come back to the next meeting in December with updates.
2. Earl Grief with Ride Idaho came in to ask to camp at a city park. He informed us that he has been doing a ride throughout Idaho trying to get to different parts every year. This will be the first time through Salmon and he is looking for a place to have the 350+ people camp for one night on August 8th. They have asked for a 30 amp service and a place to put the grey water. We are still looking for an exact location but one of the two parks will work. The Fair Board is set to do their dinner and a beer garden. We will move this on to full city council for approval.
3. The last item of discussion was updates, because of the Experience Works program, the Center was able to keep the center open for 3 days a week through September and October adding 24 days to our season. This resulted in an additional 482 people and \$2,432 in sales. The RV volunteer hours were 1,379 which was a split up between different projects on site. The Sacajawea Center Advisory Committee met for the first time and reviewed their Charter. It will go to the council for approval.
