

### **Sacajawea Team Meeting April 8, 2015**

The Sacajawea Team meeting was held April 8, 2015 at 4:30 P.M. Attending were Chairman Waidely, Councilman Bockelman and Sacajawea Director Lin Gray.

Lin presented an overview of the Docent Program for the Center. The docents take 1 four-hour shift each week from Memorial Day to Labor Day. They answer questions, provide information about Lewis and Clark and Sacajawea, take admissions and sell items in the gift shop. They meet travelers from across the country and around the world. Training provides information about local cultural and natural history as well as Interpretive Center operations. They also take pre- and post-season field trips traveling to other points of interest locally and throughout the region.

Docent Training will start April 29<sup>th</sup>. Currently there still are vacancies in the program. Lin will be on Voice of the Valley soon with more on the Docent Program.

Heritage Days Planning is in full swing. The Center is recruiting Dutch oven cooks for the annual Dutch Oven Gathering that occurs in conjunction with Heritage Days. This year's Dutch Oven Gathering is August 15<sup>th</sup> - food will be served starting at 11:00 AM with cash prizes for the top three dishes.

The Summer Youth Programs will begin in June. The Kids Garden (ages 5-12) will be every other Friday beginning June 5<sup>th</sup> from 10:00 A.M. to noon for seven sessions.

Outdoor School classes will be every Friday from June through August. Sign-ups for all programs will happen in conjunction with swimming lesson sign-ups in mid-May. There are some scholarship monies still available for these programs.

The Junior Explorer programs (ages 5-12) will be weekly (day to be determined) June-August from 11:00 A.M. to Noon. Pre-registration is not required for the Junior Explorer Program.

The Sacajawea Center is partnering with the Lemhi County Historical Society and Museum and the Salmon Arts Council to present 2015 Lemhi County History Month on Thursdays throughout June and with a field trip on June 27<sup>th</sup>. Speakers will present various talks of the history of mining in Lemhi County. This is made possible in part by a Grant from the Humanities Council funding.

The concrete work to bring the center into ADA compliance for the parking spaces and restrooms is underway. The forms and rebar have been set in place and concrete will be poured as soon as possible.

The position of Grounds Person is open and will be advertised with the Labor Department. This is a 20 Hour per week part time temporary position. Applications may be obtained at City Hall.
