**Decisions/Action Items**

- 1) Councilors approved acceptance of the COPS Grant.
- 2) Budgeting \$6,000 and \$25,000 for LCEDA and gutters and snow brakes was approved.

**COPS Grant Award**

The COPS Grant is in the amount of \$123,000 over a 3 year period. Council approved the Grant award with a motion to accept the grant funding and formally approach the County to request that they consider contributing. Roll call vote carried: Phillips...aye, Baker...aye, Hill...aye, James...aye, Bockelman...aye, and Waidely...aye.

**FY2021 BUDGET**

Amy Fealko reviewed the proposed FY2021 budget. Addressed in the review was the request from Lemhi County Economic Development Association for \$6,000 and repairs to the roof in the amount of \$25,000. Councilor Baker made a motion to fund the \$6,000. Roll call vote: Hill...aye, Bockelman...aye, Baker...aye, Phillips...aye, James...aye, and Waidely...aye.

After discussion concerning funds for building maintenance and repairs a motion was made to designate up to \$25,000 for roof and gutter maintenance from the contingency fund and start a reserve fund in the 2021/22 budgeting process. Councilor Waidely suggested moving the gutters down and getting an estimate from several contractors. Councilor Bockelman rescinded his motion. Councilor Baker then made a motion to approve \$25,000 from the contingency fund for improvements to gutters and snow brakes. Roll call vote: Waidely...aye, Bockelman...aye, James...aye, Phillips...aye, Hill...aye, Baker...aye.
